- **Please note;** to receive your delivery, you **MUST PLACE YOUR ORDER** on Flexischools by **Thursday by 4.00 pm** of that week.

- Cash is accepted on the days the Uniform Shop is open, or you can make EFT payment at the school office

PLEASE ASSIST BY PLACING ORDERS BY **FRIDAY 7TH DECEMBER 2018**

Before the start of Term 1, 2019 Flexischools orders **must be placed before or on 7th December 2018** with a “special” opening of the Uniform Shop for **PICKUPS ONLY** on the **Class Lists Day** which is posted on the noticeboard on **Friday 1st February 2019**. It is preferred only parents who are new to the school can view and purchase items on this day.

Any orders placed after the 7th December 2018 will available for collection when the **Uniform Shop officially reopens 8th February 2019**. If items are not collected at this time it will be delivered to student’s classroom.

Flexischools Online Uniform Ordering

- **Flexischools How To Guide - Ordering Uniforms:**

Once you have set up an account, enter your child/children's names and class number. Class numbers are given out a few days prior to school start when Class Lists are pinned up on noticeboards at the school, so if unknown enter last year class number for returning families or 'K1' for new Kindy students and update this before you place new orders after school starts. Click on "Top up Account" at left and add money to your account before ordering. Click on "My Students" at left then select blue "Online Ordering" box next to child's name. Scroll down to "Uniform Shop" line, select "Order Uniforms" (if you have missed that week's cut off, select the yellow "Next Week" box). Then "Add" your items and scroll down the list to choose other items. When finished select blue "Next: Select Payment" box and process your order.

Dress Code Policy

Darlington Primary has a Sun Smart School Dress Code, as endorsed by School Council in 2015.

Our Dress Code is compulsory for P-6 students (*optional but encouraged for our Kindergarten students*).

Our school dress code:

- fosters and enhances the public image of the school
- assists in building school and team spirit
- ensures students are safely dressed for specific school activities
- encourages equity among students; and
- prepares students for work, as many work places have dress and safety codes

We also have a **"No Hat, No Play" policy** for all school years. Hats must be as per the School Dress Code; bucket, broad-brimmed or Legionnaire style (*flap covering ears and neck*).

Children who have shoulder length hair are asked to keep it tied back.

Parents are asked to frequently check their children's hair for head lice. If a problem arises the school will assist with information.
